Short-term or permanent withdrawals may be requested by downloading the required form from https://registrar.aua.am/forms-2/, completing the form, and submitting it to registrar@aua.am with a copy to the student's program chair. Students are strongly encouraged to consider all implications before withdrawing from a course. Students are strongly encouraged to speak with their program chair before withdrawing from a course or the semester.

Withdrawal with a grade of "F" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 24th day through the last day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins

# 8-Week Courses

Adding/Dropping a course	Through the 5th day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "W" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 5th day through the 19th day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "F" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 20st day through the last day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins

### 5-Week Courses

Withdrawal with a grade of "W" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 4th day through the 12th day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "F" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 13th day through the last day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins

Adding/Dropping a course	Through the 3rd day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "W" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 4th day through the 9th day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "F" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 10th day through the last day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins

### 3-Week Courses

Adding/Dropping a course	Through the 2nd day of instruction
Withdrawal with a grade of "W" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 3rd day through the 8th day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
Withdrawal with a grade of "F" for all undergraduate and graduate students.	The 9th day through the last day of classes regardless of when the specific course begins
